

# Requirements for Infant/Toddler Specialist-Coach Endorsement

# **Education**

Obtain a Career Lattice Step 9b or higher from Achieve (MNCPD).

# **Employment**

Current employee or contracted staff with the Center for Inclusive Child Care (Develop Organization #838) as verified on the individual's employment tab in Develop.

# **Safety and Security Requirements**

#### These requirements must be filled before access to Develop will be granted:

Department of Human Services - Background Check is completed and verified in Develop under the Education tab.

- To request a background check, send an email to <u>TrainerRBPD.BackgroundCheck@state.mn.us</u> at the Minnesota Department of Human Services. Submit this request before applying for RBPD Specialist membership in Develop.
- The Department of Human Services utilizes the services of Castle Branch to conduct the check needed by Relationship Based Professional Development (RBPD) Specialists. Castle Branch conducts a nationwide search of criminal records. If criminal records are found in a background check, the records will be compared against <u>Minnesota Statute 245C.15</u> to determine if the record is a disqualifying crime.

Complete Course #132473 – ATL Mandated Reporter Training as verified on the coach's Learning Record.
