In September, DHS announced <u>Upcoming Changes for the DHS Early Childhood</u> <u>and School-Age Care Professional Development System</u>.

As a result of these changes, you must sign the newly updated Trainer Agreement Form and return it to support@mncpd.org by November 20, 2021, to maintain your approved trainer membership status in Develop.

Updated Trainer Quality Concerns Policy

Released September 2021, the updated <u>Trainer Quality Concerns Policy</u> ensures transparency and fairness for everyone involved in the process and allows accountability for Trainers, course writers, and Training Sponsor Organizations. These concerns will be handled by Achieve in partnership with TARSS and supported by the TTET and a newly revamped Trainer Agreement Form.


